Becoming a Home-Schooled Student at NHTI Is Easy

1. Apply for Admission

Great news: There is no application fee! If you fill out the online application, you will need to create a new account; click "First time user account creation" and follow the instructions.

While the nature of home schooling is unique to each student, NHTI requires appropriate documentation, which may include the following:

1. A letter from your local school district stating you have completed a home school program at the high school level
2. A list of courses taken and grades earned and/or portfolio of work accomplished
3. High school equivalency or other testing, if applicable
4. An official transcript if your home school curriculum is provided by a U.S. regionally accredited school
